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Patient Safety: Decreasing Hemodialysis Catheter Infections and Peritonitis

Please join Qsource ESRD Networks and Telligen for a patient safety webinar. Infection in the access is the most common cause of infection among people who undergo dialysis. This is because of their increased risk for infection due to altered or compromised immune systems, existing comorbidities, frequent need for hospitalizations, and so forth. Anytime the patient's access is used, they are put at risk for infection if proper technique is not followed. This webinar will discuss ways to prevent these infections from occurring, as well as proper care that should be taken with the dialysis access.
