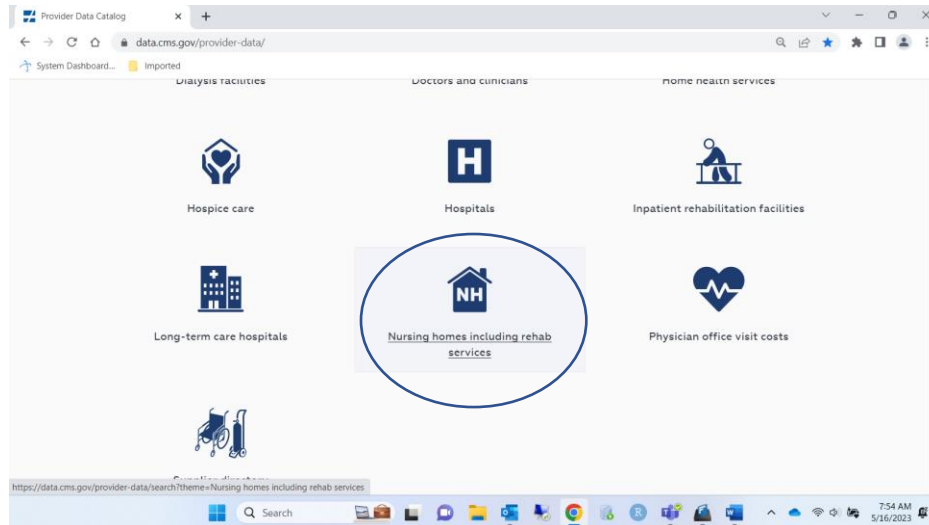




Accessing Nursing Home Publicly Reported Data From CMS' Care Compare Website

Access publicly reported data at <https://data.cms.gov/provider-data/>. Then scroll down and click on the nursing home image to get to nursing home related measure data.



Click on any table name to find out more about the data contained within each table. For example, if you click on Skilled Nursing Facility Quality Reporting Program - Provider Data, you can find data related to the SNF HAI infection measure that may be of interest at the nursing home level.

You can filter what's showing on the screen to find data for one nursing home provider at a time or on the right middle side of the page are helpful links to download the entire data set to .csv and a link to download the data dictionary for all nursing home data sets to learn more about information contained in the data sets.



Provider Data

Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs) provide Medicare Part A SNF services to beneficiaries and must report data on certain measures of quality to Medicare through the Skilled Nursing Facility Quality Reporting Program (SNF QRP). This file contains a list of SNFs, as well as their results on the quality of resident care measures implemented under the IMPACT Act.

The SNF QRP measure related to hospitalizations from infections is labeled as “S_039_01: Percentage of infections patients got during their SNF stay that resulted in hospitalization.” So, any variables in the data set with S_039_01 contained in the variable name would be related to this measure.

Another data table with measures that may be of interest is the Medicare Claims Quality Measures data set. This data set contains measures related to 30-day rehospitalizations for short-stay nursing home residents and ED visits for short-stay residents within 30 days of a hospital discharge.
